## **Youth Leadership Expectations**

*Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in life, in faith and in purity. 1 Timothy 4:12*

### **INTRODUCTION**

We see our Youth Ministry Program here at Hope as a journey of faith. In “the Way” (4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grades) we strive to set young people on the right path, showing them that faith can be fun and meaningful while facilitating the growth of community and social networks for our young people. In “the Truth” (7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade) our young people learn the truths about the Bible, the church, the creeds and the traditions of our Lutheran heritage while having opportunities to put faith in action together with friends and in service to others. In “the Life” (9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grades) our youth choose to put their faith into practice on a regular basis. Through youth groups, fellowship events, lessons, worship and service our young people learn what it's like to take their faith seriously and to pursue a personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

*This leadership opportunity is for 10<sup>th</sup> -12<sup>th</sup> graders who have actively participated in youth ministry at Hope for more than 6 months and who would like the chance to grow in their faith by serving and leading their peers, together with our youth ministry STAFF.*

- Personal growth through Bible study and prayer
- Modeling a healthy commitment to my family
- Choices, a lifestyle, and attitudes that are Godly, knowing that my leadership is a model for other students and those around me
- “Being a Light” on my campus, in my neighborhood, and in my home
- Lead a lifestyle of humility in which I am teachable and willing to grow in my faith

### **LEADERSHIP EXPECTATIONS**

- Regular weekly attendance on Wednesday nights, Sunday mornings and Sunday nights.
- Being an example of proper behavior during worship services, programs, and activities
- Promote an atmosphere of acceptance at all YOUTH gatherings by seeking out new and unfamiliar faces, by actively including students that seem unconnected, and by befriending others different from me
- Willing to meet with and assist Youth Staff
- Serve on a ministry team
- Complete weekly assignments and devotions
- Will be at meetings on time and bring a Bible, notebook, and a pen

### **TIME COMMITMENT**

- Yearlong commitment from September to June
- Weekly Sunday meetings 4:30-5:45 pm (first meeting on Sunday, September 12, 2010)
- Attending all scheduled leadership meetings and events
- Regularly attending Wednesday and Sunday nights
- Regularly attending Sunday worship
